

Organ Transplant Coordinator - RN

The Organ Transplant Coordinator ensures the delivery of health care services from post-transplant surgery through the transplant maintenance phase. Responsibilities include care coordination of post-transplant patients, medication education, organ rejection monitoring and scheduling treatments as needed. This position requires a confident RN who can work independently and be personally responsible for a patient roster making decisions independently. This person will be coordinating transplant patients through their post-transplant care.

An experienced RN with 2 to 3 years general nursing, med surg, nephrology or dialysis exposure preferred. ICU experience would be relevant. Must be able to work with a fast-paced team. Experience with quality process improvement a plus. Attention to detail is extremely important as the transplant program has a high number of regulatory demands.

This role will require occasional off hours call responsibilities.

Qualifications

- Graduate from an accredited Nursing Program required.
- Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (BSN) with 3 years of clinical experience required.
- 2 years of nephrology nursing experience preferred.
- Demonstrated clinical competence in the area of organ transplantation.

- Licensed Registered Nurse in New Hampshire required.
- Basic Life Support (BLS) Certificate required.
