QUALIFICATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Undergraduate degree in health sciences or equivalent. RN licensure preferred. Master's degree or equivalent preferred. Five years' experience as a procurement coordinator or similar role in the organ procurement industry. Previous supervision of professional staff required.
2. Proven ability to lead a team, coordinate internal and external resources and achieve measurable results against goals.
3. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills. Strong analytical and problem-solving skills.
4. Strong organizational, problem analysis and decision-making skills. Demonstrated ability to motivate peers and achieve cooperation.
5. Must have and maintain CPTC certification
6. Microsoft office proficiency required.
7. Ability to work a minimum of 40 hours per week and participate in 24-hour call. Required to work for extended periods of time with few breaks.
8. Must maintain a valid driver's license in accordance with MTN motor vehicle policy. Must have reliable personal automobile transportation to be used with company reimbursement using IRS guidelines. Must be able to travel within the service area by ground or air.
9. Ability to lift 50 pounds.
10. Possess manual dexterity sufficient to operate telephones, computers and surgical equipment.
11. Ability to speak and communicate clearly in order to accurately convey information to donor families, hospital staff and transplant/procurement personnel in person or by phone.
12. Ability to hear at normal audio levels of speaking whether in person or over the phone.

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
