Leads compliance efforts for transplant-related regulatory agencies, inclusive of CMS, UNOS, The Joint Commission and ESRD Network 4. Represents PTI in organizational quality, patient safety and regulatory compliance initiatives and collaborates with entity departments to maximize transplant outcomes.
