Position Summary:

This position ensures coordination and continuity of patient care for transplant patients in order to maintain organized, efficient care and provide support to staff and other healthcare professionals. Responsible for identifying the patient's alterations in health; assessing the patient's response to treatment protocols; communicating appropriate data to physician staff; implementing nursing interventions based upon established treatment protocols; and anticipating potential outcomes for patients at risk for complications. Must demonstrate ability to assess data reflective of the patient's status and interpret the appropriate information needed to identify each patient's requirements relative to age-specific needs and organ(s) transplanted and provide care according to protocols and within practice of nursing.

Requirements:

- Graduate of an accredited four (4) year, baccalaureate program in nursing; master's degree in nursing or Master's degree "eligible" (i.e. completion of academic coursework) or related health care field preferred
- Current RN licensure; ARNP in Florida preferred
- Minimum of three years' experience in nursing with at least two (2) years' experience in critical care or transplantation
- Must be knowledgeable in transplant immunology, technical aspects of surgery, interpretation of diagnostic and laboratory data, and clinical management of patients
