The Clinical Manager develops and ensures adherence to the standard of care, process improvement, maintenance of regulatory compliance and personnel management. Oversees staff to ensure proper oversight of the thoracic transplant and ventricular assist device programs.

The Clinical Manager is involved in ensuring optimal patient outcomes through effective leadership and / or provision of patient care delivery in assigned nursing unit(s) or area(s). Promotes environment for a shared voice in nursing practice and exchange of ideas to continually improve nursing and patient care outcomes. Accountable for the quality, safety, patient experience and cost-effectiveness of patient care. Consults and collaborates with other health care professionals to coordinate the management of patient care. Serves as a resource to staff, physicians, students and others.
