Minimum - Registered Nurse licensed in the State of Wisconsin

Physical Requirements:

Light: Ability to lift up to 20 pounds maximum with frequent lifting and/or carrying of objects weighing up to 10 pounds.

Work Schedule:

100%FTE, 40 hours. Monday - Friday between the hours of 7:00 AM - 5:00 PM. Hours may vary based on the operational needs of the department. On-Call Responsibility - Provide on-call service on evenings, weekends and holidays when the transplant office and Clinic is closed.
