MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Education: Graduate of accredited nursing program. BSN required within 5 years of hire.
- Experience: 1 year.
- License/Certification: Licensed to practice as RN in Virginia. May require valid Virginia driver's license. American Heart Association Healthcare Provider BLS required.
