

## Certified Clinical Transplant Dietitian (CCTD) Re-certification Criteria

The CCTD Certification is valid for three years from date of issuance. Recertification requirements are listed below. Eligibility will be evaluated by the CCTD Workgroup.

**\*\* Important: Please read all FAQs prior to application submission \*\***

### ***Core Eligibility Requirements***

To be eligible for re-certification, applicants must maintain both core eligibility requirements.

❖ **Active Registered Dietitian**

- Active with the Commission of Dietetic Registration (CDR) credential or a body determined to be equivalent if not located in the United States.

❖ **Transplant Dietitian Experience** – Minimum of **3,120 hours** of transplant experience during the 3-year certification cycle.

**Have continued in the role of transplant dietitian with experience including:**

- Interaction with transplant candidates, recipients, and living donors
- Participation in multidisciplinary transplant meetings (e.g., MRB, QAPI)
- Attendance at transplant rounds and involvement in research or quality improvement initiatives
- Providing transplant-related nutrition education to staff

### ***Additional Eligibility Requirements***

To be eligible for certification as a CCTD, individuals must meet both core requirements outlined above and have completed at least one of the following in the prior **3 years**:

Option	What Counts	Documentation Required
<b>Published Work</b>	Peer-reviewed transplant nutrition article or book chapter	Copy of manuscript
<b>Oral Presentation</b>	Presentation on transplant nutrition at a national transplant or national nutrition conference (including roundtable/panel)	Copy of presentation + conference agenda
<b>Webinar Presentation</b>	Webinar on transplant nutrition for a national transplant or nutrition organization	Copy of webinar presentation
<b>Poster Presentation</b>	Poster on transplant nutrition at a national transplant conference	Copy of poster + conference agenda
<b>Committee Service</b>	Served ≥ 1 year on a national committee related to transplant/transplant nutrition	Written proof from committee lead including hours/time served
<b>Continuing Education (CEUs)</b>	Minimum of 20 transplant-specific CEUs	Spreadsheet to include title of education presentation, date of completion, CEU credits and type (CDR, Category 1 CME/AMA PRA, CEPTC), copy of certificate

**Tip:** Regional or hospital-based presentations may qualify for partial CEU credit. See FAQs for full guidance.

## Certification Fee

Applicant Type	Fee	Includes
Re-certification for Existing NATCO Members (with $\geq$ 6 months of membership at the time of application)	\$50	\$25 administration fee, application cost
Re-certification with a 1-year NATCO membership	\$235	\$25 administration fee, application cost, 1-year NATCO membership
Re-certification for Non-NATCO Members (Membership not included)	\$235	\$25 administration fee, application cost only
