

Procurement Transplant Coordinator

The Core Competencies for the Procurement Practitioner outline general practitioner/coordinator competencies that are broad in scope to acknowledge the diverse professional practices unique to each organ and tissue procurement organization. They are meant to be applicable to both adult and pediatric donors and cover 13 categories, including:

- 2. Organ and Tissue Donor Evaluation
- 3. Family Approach and Consent
- 4. Medical/Social History Interview
- 5. Medical-Legal Activities
- 6. Organ Donor Management
- 7. Organ Allocation
- 8. Surgical Recovery and Organ and Tissue Preservation
- 9. Donor Records
- 10. Family Post-Donation Communication
- 11. Hospital Post-Donation Communication
- 12. Professional Development
- 13. Professional Practice
